She works in close consultation with the Department of Psychiatry and also provides strategic direction and leadership to further the policy goals of the Children's Mental Health Campaign.

Before joining the government relations team, Azubuike worked in the Office of General Counsel at Boston Children's Hospital, where she implemented and staffed the hospital's first Medical-Legal Partnership program. Azubuike also served as an assistant attorney general at the office of Massachusetts Attorney General Maura Healey '98 and as a judicial law clerk for the Delaware Family Court. She is a graduate of the University of Massachusetts Amherst and the George Washington University Law School.

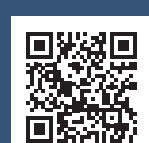
