Other actions to take:

- Talk openly about abortion, support it, name it, normalize it, including as health care
- If you are comfortable, share your abortion stories, to normalize it, take the stigma away
- Have events and invite Repro Rights Activists to speak at it for fundraising or invite state senators and school board members to your house and talk about it.

- Send in a class note to your college or university and mention you are working on repro rights
- Get a pro abortion sticker and put it on your car
- Look at local prosecutor races and District Attorney Races, these are key
- Tell Congress to Support the Women’s Health Protection Act:

- Vote for candidates (up and down the ticket, especially locally) committed to abortion rights—including state court judges
- Vote for ballot initiatives that will protect abortion rights— Kentucky, New Hampshire, and Kansas all have ballot initiatives this fall; Michigan just submitted signatures to put abortion rights on the ballot
- Arm friends / families in other jurisdictions to vote and support candidates committed to abortion rights
- If you are an attorney – consider how your knowledge base could be of pro bono help (E.g., helping doctors who are leaving anti-abortion states and setting up practices in pro-abortion states (they will need help with licensing, new leases, entity formation, malpractice insurance, affiliating with hospitals, etc.)
- If you are a General Counsel or head of HR or other C-Suite executive, talk openly about abortion and push for policies supporting employees.
